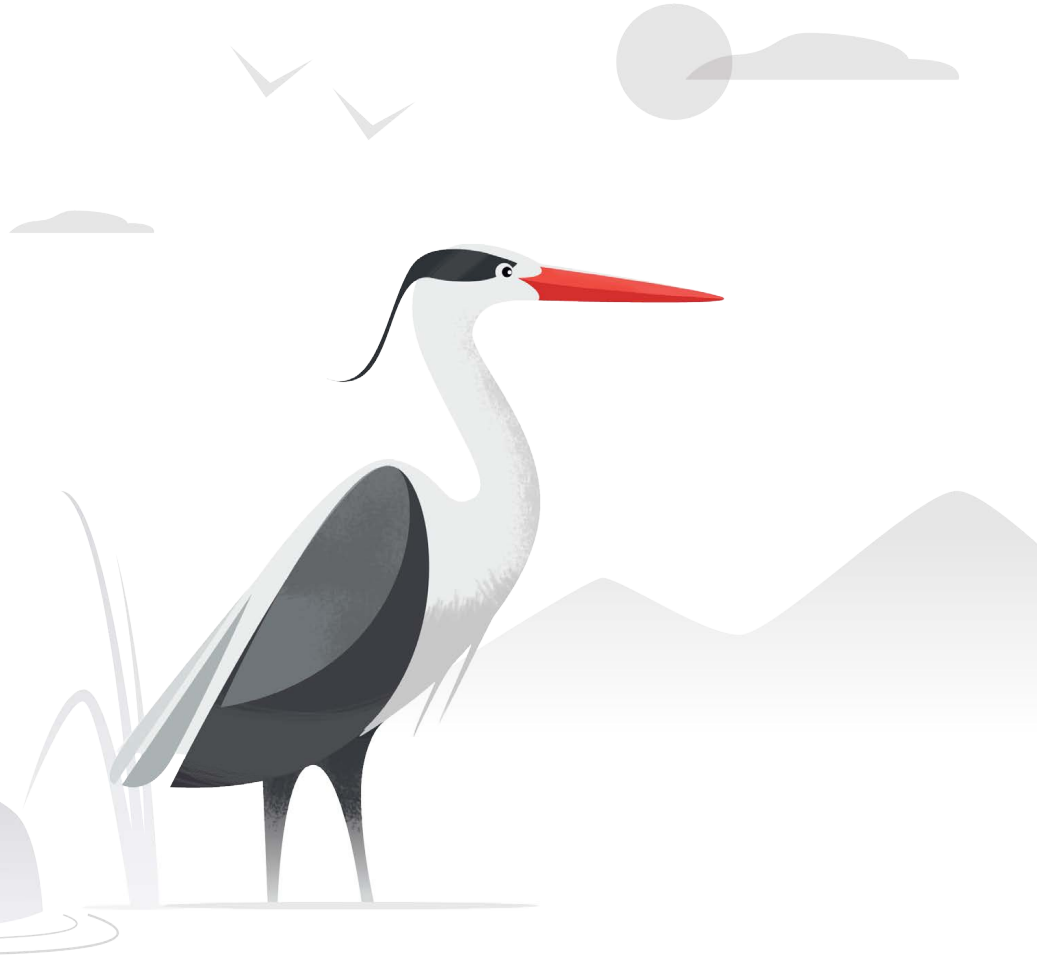

Anonymization menu

Feature	Description	Context	Benefits	Live
UI improvement	Revamped anonymization menu in the “Personal Data” tab offering clear options and an explicit warning before anonymization	Feature used by CDOs and Data Stewards to anonymize personal data in the context of the GDPR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Improved user experience through a clearer and more efficient anonymization setup - Easier compliance with the GDPR 	December 2017

Personal data settings

User consent field
Field that contains the user consent information.

Entry date field
Field that contains the user entry date in the dataset.

Fields to anonymize
Choose the fields that need anonymization.
Supported field types are: bigint, boolean, char, date, decimal, double, float, int, integer, interval, numeric, smallint, string, timestamp, tinyint, varchar

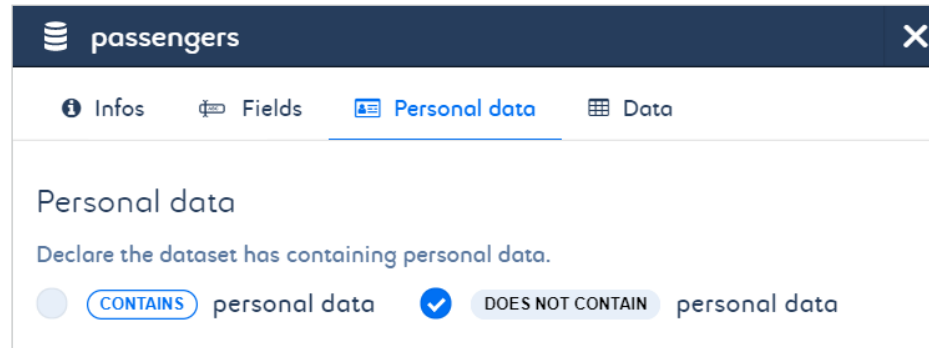
